Development of three regulated qualifications

- HIGHER DIPLOMA – IN THEOLOGY (level 6)
- DIPLOMA IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES (Level 5)
- CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY (Level 4)

Current programmes delivered by All Nations Bible College

Level 6 Diploma in Theology

The aim is to provide students with strong biblical leadership and spiritual education for the enhancement of their effectiveness in life and Ministry. This programme is focused on missional and biblical theology, with practical application.

Length: 1 year

Current mode of assessment: 3 written assignments that contribute 70% of a module's final assessment, and oral class presentations/debates which are sometimes used for grading purposes along with essays. 3,000 word dissertation is required.

Course delivery methods:

- Classroom lectures
- Seminars
- Practical Workshops
- Video Classes
- Field works in Churches/Communities
- Joint practical Projects

Level 5 Diploma in Theological Studies

The course combines theological and biblical study with a mission emphasis and practical work experience. You will gain an understanding of theology and explore the foundations of Christian belief, practice and ministry within your chosen placement or training context.

Length: 6 months



Current mode of assessment: 2 written assignments that contribute 70% of a module's final assessment, and oral class presentations/debates that are sometimes used for grading purposes along with essays. 1,500 word Dissertation - Theology Report and Classroom presentation

Course delivery methods:

- Classroom lectures
- Seminars
- Practical Workshops
- Video Classes
- Field works in Churches/Communities
- Joint practical Projects

Level 4 Certificate in Christian Ministry

The Certificate in Ministry Studies course is directed at persons' already in the Ministry and those who are preparing for different levels and spheres of ministerial and leadership engagement in the Church.

Length: 8 weeks

Current mode of assessment: 1 written assignment that contribute 70% of a module's final assessment, and oral class presentations/debates that are sometimes used for grading purposes along with essays. 1500 word Report and Classroom presentation

Course delivery methods:

- Classroom lectures
- Seminars
- Practical Workshops
- Video Classes
- Field works in Churches/Communities

Progression

These qualifications will provide progression to higher education or enhance career development within the Church. (NB we will need to understand progression routes for each qualification.)

Entry Requirements/Learner Profile

- To be agreed, however learners must be proficient in the English language

Proposed scope of qualifications and size of units

The current proposals reflect initial discussions and the overall length of each programme. Further clarification is needed about the number of assessments that there currently are for each qualification and how these relate to the various units.

- Level 6 Diploma in Theology (120 credits/1200 Total Qualification Hours) – 5 core units, 14 optional units (ANBC to confirm this)



- Level 5 Diploma in Theological Studies (60 credits) – 600 Total Qualification Hours – 9 units
- Level 4 Certificate in Christian Ministry (30 credits) – 300 Total Qualification Hours – 6 units

(NB Total qualification time (TQT) is the total time for a learner to achieve the qualification including research/private study and assessment. We are required to produce this for the regulators.)

Assessment

- To be finalised once scope of qualifications is agreed. Assignments and other material will be provided by ANBC for selected units. ATHE will quality assure these before the qualification is delivered.
